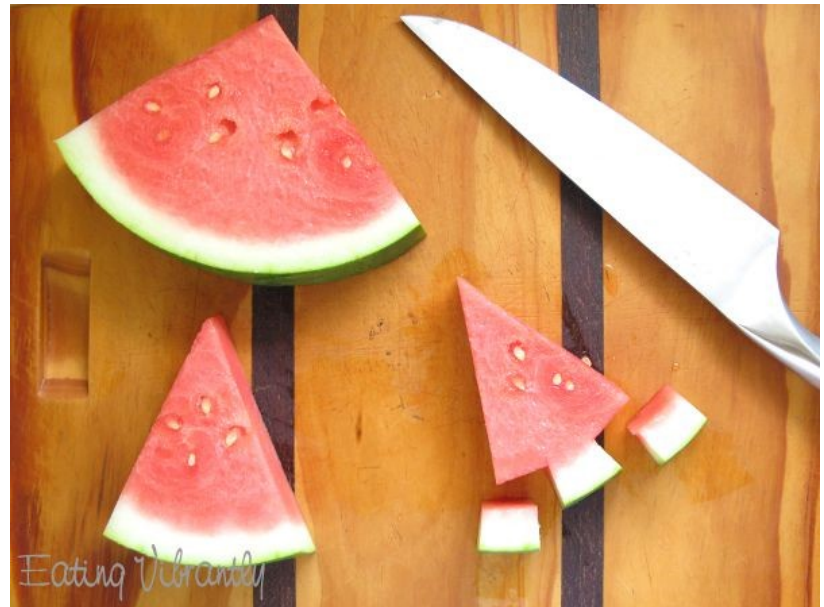

The Frozen T-Shirt Game

Wet, fold and freeze large t-shirts 24 hours in advance, and set a timer to see which player can open it and put it on the fastest!

Frozen Hot Chocolate

INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 cups chocolate chips or 4 oz of chocolate
- 2 tsp. hot cocoa mix
- 1 1/2 Tbsp sugar
- 1 1/2 cup milk divided
- 3 cup ice cubes
- sweetened whipped cream
- chocolate sprinkles optional



INSTRUCTIONS

Chop chocolate into small pieces and melt in a glass container in microwave for 10-20 second intervals until melted.

Add in hot cocoa mix and sugar to melted chocolate. Mix until blended.

Add in 1/2 C milk, stir until smooth. Allow to cool to room temperature

In blender, place remaining milk, cooled chocolate mixture and ice cubes

Blend on high speed until smooth and consistency of a frozen daiquiri

Pour into mugs and top with whipped cream and sprinkles.
